¹ The case does not constitute the criminal offence of war crime, however, we do monitor the proceedings since it is the case of instigation of an offence of murder of Croatian policemen which took place at the beginning of the armed conflicts. On 04 August 1991, in Budačka Rijeka, three Croatian policemen had been murdered and one Croatian policeman had been wounded. The accused Dakić was tried in absence and sentenced to 20 years in prison. In May 2011, Dakić was arrested in Bosnia and Herzegovina. He was extradited to Croatia in August 2011.
